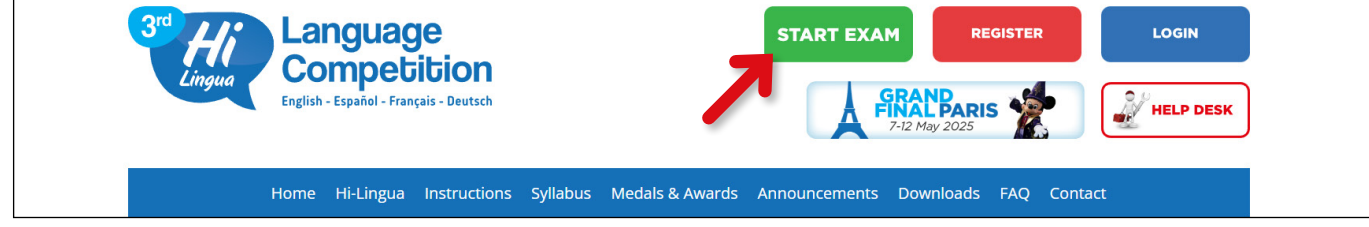

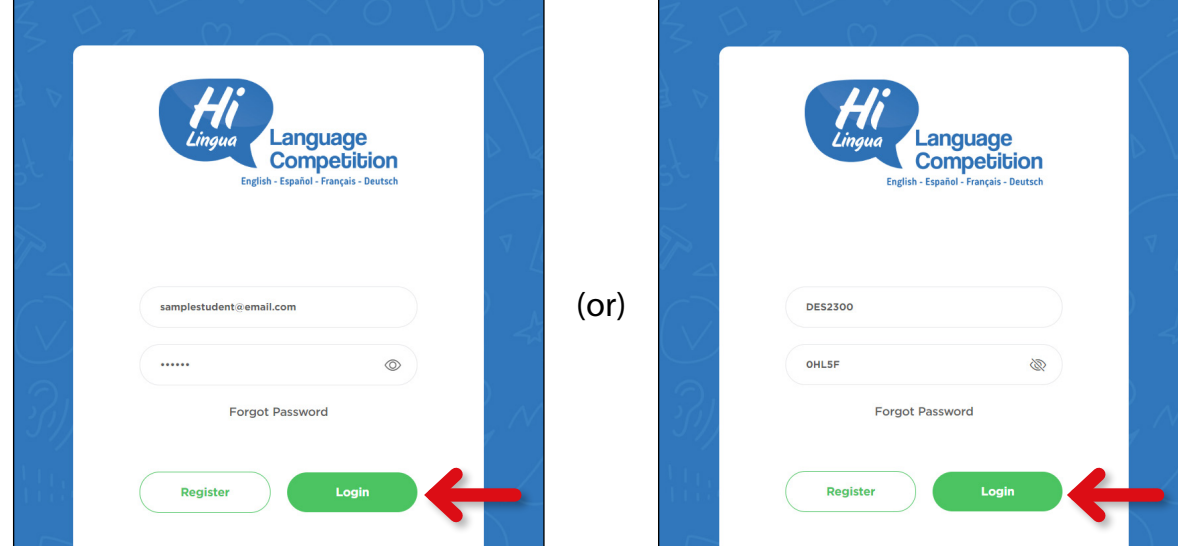

**EXAM Time:** 09:00 - 18:00 (in your local time)

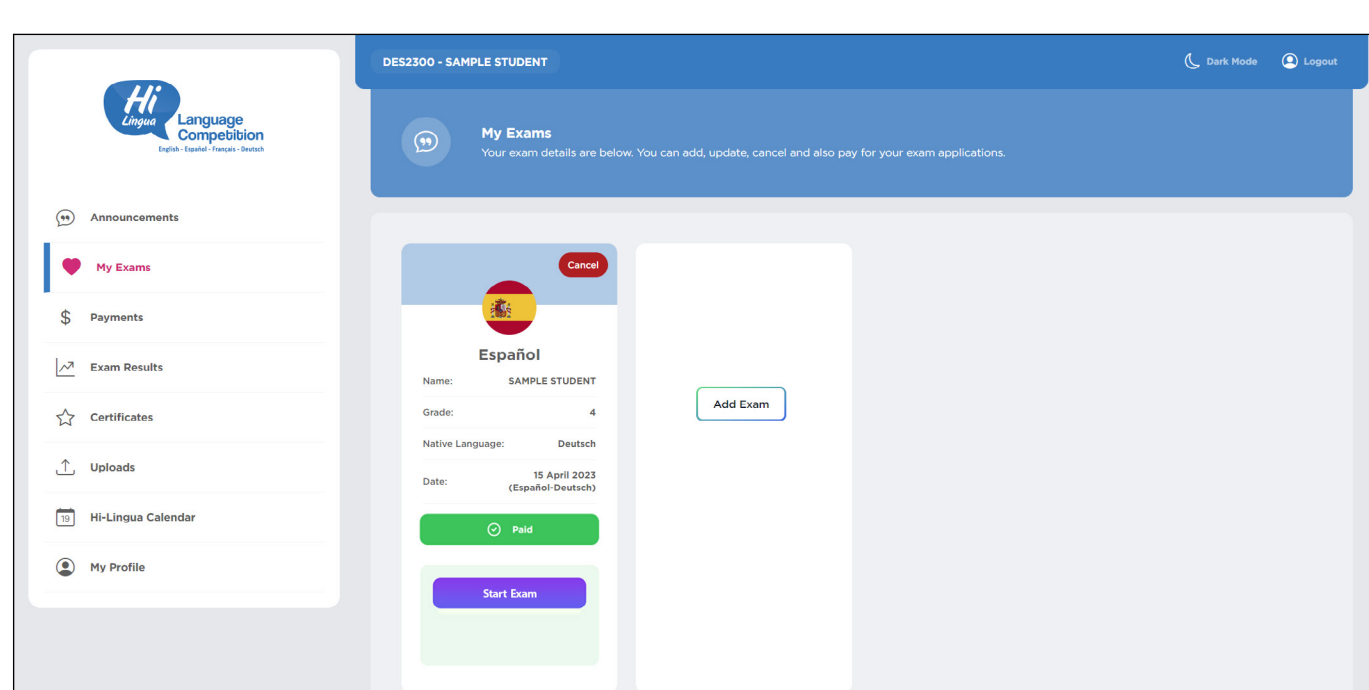
1 Go to <https://hi-lingua.org/> website and click the **START EXAM** button.



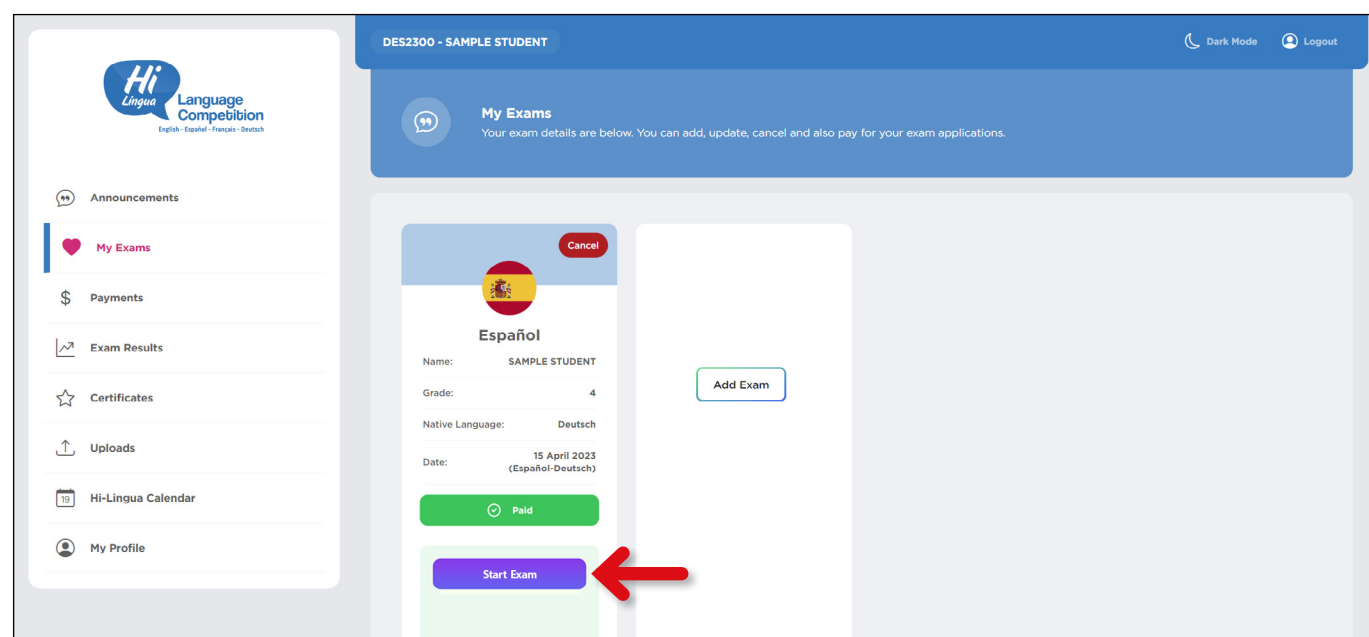
2 You can always log in to your student account using your **Student ID** and **Reference Code** as well as your **email address** and **password** that you submitted while registration.



3 If you have registered and paid for more than one category you can take the exams in order.



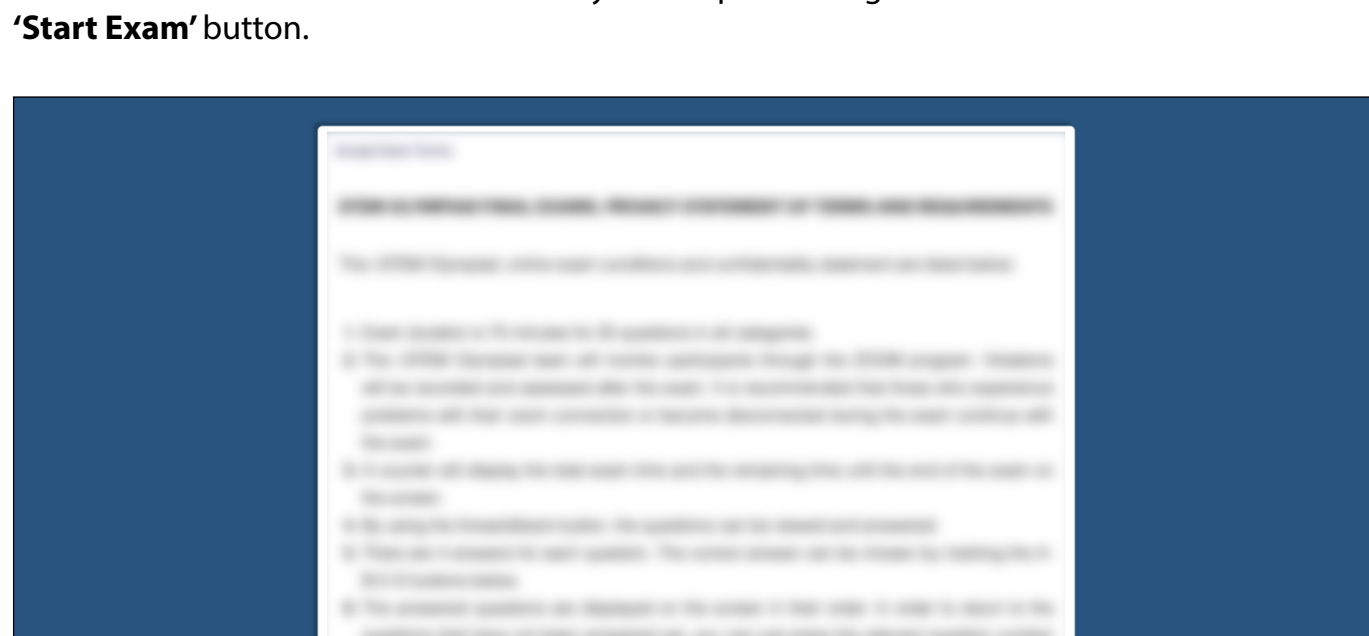
4 Click the **Start Exam** button.



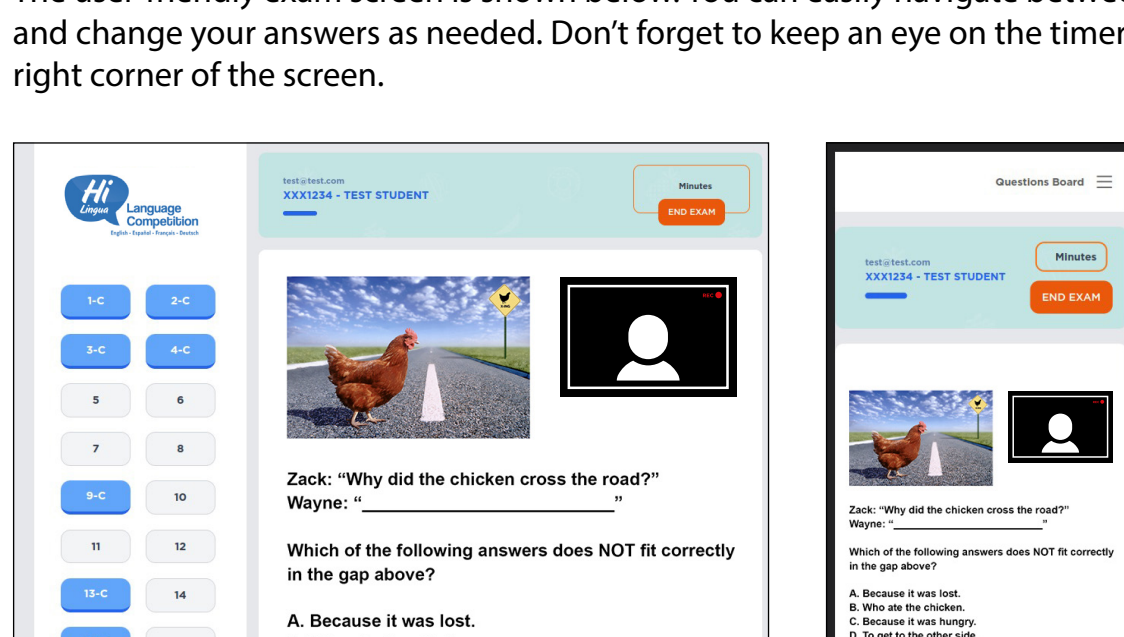
5 Please connect your camera and adjust the camera angle. Then, click on **'Start Exam'** again.



6 Please read the exam conditions carefully before proceeding to the trial exam and click the **'Start Exam'** button.



7 The user-friendly exam screen is shown below. You can easily navigate between the questions and right corner of the answers. Don't forget to keep an eye on the timer in the upper right corner of the screen.



### HI-LINGUA LANGUAGE COMPETITION EXAMS, PRIVACY STATEMENT OF TERMS AND REQUIREMENTS ALTERNATIVE EXAMS FOR THE GRAND FINAL ON 19 JANUARY 2025

1. The exam platform **will be accessible from 09:00 to 18:00**, according to local time in each country.
2. The camera connection is required during the exam. The camera must be turned on.
3. If you do not have an internal camera on your computer, you can use your mobile phone as an external camera.
4. The Hi-Lingua team will monitor participants through the admin panel. Violations will be recorded and assessed after the exam.
5. The exam includes 40 questions in each language category and lasts for **60 minutes**.
6. Each question has 2.5 points. A participant who answers all the questions correctly will receive 100 points (2.5 points x 40 questions = 100 points).
7. **Each incorrect answer will deduct 2 points from the participant's total score.**
8. In case of a tie in scores, the ranking is determined based on the exam completion time.
9. If a student finishes the exam early and clicks the 'END EXAM' button, the exam cannot be reactivated.
10. If you accidentally close the browser or leave the exam platform due to a technical issue (such as a power or internet outage), you can log back in and resume where you left off. Your answers will not be deleted. However, the time will continue to pass.
11. A warning message will appear on the screen if you leave the Hi-Lingua exam portal. Violations will be recorded by the system. **Each tab error will deduct 0.5 points from the overall score.**
12. Please immediately report any technical issue you experience by filling out the **HELP DESK** form via the homepage. Your message will be responded to as soon as possible. Also, remember to check your spam folder for responses.
13. Copying, photographing, reproducing, sharing or archiving questions from the exam screen is strictly prohibited. The exams of those responsible will be canceled in case of violations in this regard.
